

Club Site Access Policy

Clubsite Access Arrangements

At the Annual General Meeting 27th November 2015 members requested a restricted key policy be maintained to ensure the safety and security of both club and private equipment stored therein.

Committee Officers and authorised keyholders are available if members need access to the club-site. Their contact details are posted on the notice-board, in the *Members Only* section of the club forum.

To enable fairness to all, please abide by the following

- 1. In so far as possible, please contact keyholders initially by text at least 24 hours in advance of when you need access.
- 2. You are expected to arrange a return time when organising initial access.
- 3. Peer groups should organise <u>One</u> Collection & Return appointment.
- 4. Please respect that ALL keyholders are responsible for signing In/Out equipment and collecting rental fees as per the Club's Equipment Hire & Usage Policy.
- 5. No access to the river will be provided without the presence of an Instructor or suitably qualified paddler. In <u>all</u> instances, members must satisfy themselves of their ability to paddle in the conditions present on a given day; Ref: Safety Policy.
- 6. Only fully paid-up members are eligible to hold keys.

Note: Clubhouse access is being provided to facilitate members paddling outside of official club sessions, those members availing of this service should have contingency arrangements for safe storage of equipment overnight if clubhouse cannot be accessed.
